- Scotch Prisoners. 1650/1.

"Ordered, that the Council of State do take into Consideration, what Prisoners of the Scottish Nation have been taken during these Wars either in England or Scotland; and to make an exact List of them, and how they have been disposed of, and where they now are; and report the same to the Parliament with all Speed &c.

Thursday 3 Feb. 1652.

Lenthall, Speaker of Parliament. Annexed to this
letter was a list of Scots officers captured; viz:
1 Lt.-Gen.; 3 Colonels; 11 Lt.-Cols.; 9 Majors; 47 Captains
7 Capt.-Lts.; 1 Adjt.-Gen.; 70 Lieutenants; 12 Cornets
4 Quarter Masters; 78 Ensigns. As all below the
rank of captain were liable to be sent to the
plantations, there are 171 names on this list of
that rank.
